Alternative Options for Meeting Continuing Competency Requirements

The continuing competency criterion for renewal of your AHNCC certification is the equivalent of 100 education hours in your specialty (i.e. holistic nursing or nurse coaching) and related disciplines. Contact hours must have been acquired from the date of your last certification to the date for renewal and submission of your recertification application. Continuing competency means that you have completed learning experiences that result in updating and expanding your knowledge, and skills in your specialty. Therefore, credit is given for appropriate continued education courses and alternative and equivalent activities such as publishing, presentations at conferences, and academic courses in your specialty. Specific information follows:

Contact hours may address holistic integrative nursing, theories, theorists or major concepts such as spirituality, intention, holistic self-care, sacred space or presence that are relevant to your practice. They can also be related holistic, integrative modalities, methods of practice, communication skills. relationship-based patientcentered care, and studies that facilitate

self-care, growth, and transformation within a holistic context. For individuals certified in nurse coaching, content focused on the skills, attitudes, and knowledge related to the role of nurse coaching can also be submitted.

Medical focused courses will not be accepted unless you can explain how they relate to your practice. Courses that are considered basic nursing preparation and courses for lay people are not accepted.

Specific written documentation must be provided if audited.

Frequently Asked Questions

Question: "What Continuing Education activities or Alternative activities can be submitted to meet my 100 Continuing Competency hours required to renew my Holistic Nurse or Nurse Coach credentials?

Answer: Any CE program or alternative continuing competency activity that builds your knowledge base, skills, understanding, attitudes and/or expertise in holistic nursing, holism, holistic health, and nurse coaching health related content will be accepted. All 100 hours must relate to holistic nursing, holistic health, nurse coaching, etc. They can not be related to medicine unless you are able to articulate why this knowledge is essential to your HN or NC certification. If you have questions if a program or activity is accepted you can ask if it is approved at info@ahncc.org. A list can be found here.
