

We frequently get the question, "What is the difference between Holistic Nursing and Nurse Coaching?" Although both holistic nurses and nurse coaches practice within a foundation of Holism, the focus of their care is different.

What is Holistic Nursing?

Holistic nursing is defined as all nursing practice that provides care for the person as an integrated, holistic human being, inseparable and integral with the environment. Holistic practice draws on holistic nursing knowledge, theories, expertise, different ways of knowing, and intuition to guide nurses in becoming therapeutic partners with clients in a mutually evolving process toward healing and holism. Holistic Nursing is universal in nature and may be practiced in any clinical setting, community, private practice, hospital, educational institution, or research foundation; with the understanding that clients are the experts of their needs and care is always planned for and provided within the context of their culture, perceptions, values, and belief system.

What is Nurse Coaching?


Nurse Coaching is a skilled, purposeful, results-oriented, and structured relationship-centered, interaction-based role with clients based in the precepts of Holistic Nursing wherein clients are facilitated in achieving health-focused goals. Relationships are based on goal accomplishment and tend to be short-term. Nurse Coaches are educated in advanced communication strategies, skills, and knowledge with the understanding that clients are the experts of their needs and care is always planned for and provided within the context of their culture, perceptions, values, and belief system.

How is Nurse Coaching related to Holistic Nursing?

Holistic nursing is a way of thinking and doing. **Nurse Coaching** is a role within nursing that uses holistic nursing principles.

Why Become Recertified?

Certification is a professional pathway to validate your nursing specialty knowledge, competence, and expertise. With today's healthcare focus on health promotion, wellness, and well-being your certification provides evidence and assures consumers, employers, and other key stakeholders that you are a leader in healthcare transformation.

AHNCC certification is good for five years. If not renewed before the end of the five years, credentials become inactive and are not authorized for use. You can recertify at any time during the inactive period which lasts three years. After three years the credentials become expired and you must resit for the exam to continue using them. All AHNCC certification examinations are nationally accredited through the Accreditation Board for Specialty Nursing Certification (ABSNC) www.nursingcertification.org and are recognized by ANCC as Magnet approved for institutions seeking or reapplying for Magnet status and can be found in the ANCC DDCT at https://absnc.org/certification/accredited-programs.

"When Healthcare isn't Caring: Stigma and Health Disparities among Transgender and Gender-Diverse People"



Transgender and gender diverse (TGD) people experience clear and pervasive patterns and mistreatment and discrimination across several social domains, including access to healthcare services.



According to the 2015 U.S. Transgender Survey, a landmark survey of more than 27,000 TGD adults in the U.S., 33% have reported at least one negative healthcare experience related to their gender identity. Consequently, approximately 31% of TGD people delayed or avoided medically

necessary care to avoid stigma-related experiences. Nurses have a moral, ethical, and professional obligation to address these health disparities. In this presentation, Anthony Velasco will discuss, using a social justice lens, how nurses can develop culturally informed and evidence-based interventions responsive to the needs of the TGD community.

Anthony Velasco, MS, APRN, AGPCNP-BC, CNS, PHN, CMSRN, ACRN, AAHIVS (he/him, they/them) is a Ph.D. candidate in the College of Nursing at the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus.

He currently practices clinically at Desert AIDS Project, a federally qualified health center that provides care to underserved communities in the inland desert region of Southern California. He led the creation of a regionally recognized gender-affirming care program, was presented with the Stonewall Humanitarian Award by the Transgender Community Coalition, and was chosen as this year's Johnson and Johnson Health Equity Scholar. His research explores the interrelationship between experience of multilevel stigma, primary care access, and social determinants of health on the health and health-related experiences of transgender and gender-diverse older adults. In each of his professional endeavors, he derives the greatest joy from building collaborative relationships with his patients and partnering with his community in creating patientcentered, culturally informed, and evidence-based interventions to improve healthcare access and create structural changes that meet the unique needs of systemically minoritized communities.

AHNCC Fellowships Holistic Nurse Fellowship Program

Holistic Nursing **Fellowship** Program was launched in 2022 through a collaborative effort between the American Holistic Nurses Credentialing Corporation (AHNCC) and American Holistic Nurses Association (AHNA). Through this alliance. AHNCC and AHNA are partnering with other nursing organizations to increase inclusivity and diversity among our certificants and membership. This Fellowship is offered on the even years at this time. They are not available to individuals but only thru the membership organizations.

At the beginning of the Fellowship, fellows are provided with a board-certified holistic nurse mentor who will facilitate them in preparing for the national Holistic Nursing certification examination and help them navigate through the application process.

The Fellow will have 2 years to complete the Fellowship program and take the certification examination. A certificate will be provided to participants upon completion of the Fellowship program. Upon completion,

participants can also include the Fellowship completion in their CVs.

Each year, the AHNCC Equality, Equity, Diversity, Inclusion, and Social Justice (EEDISJ) Committee looks at a list of identified nursing organizations that are focused on diverse nursing populations. They select and invite the next two organizations to participate.

The invited organizations then select the fellow from their membership.

In this two-year Fellowship, recipients are offered a packet that is valued at over \$1400.00 and includes the following:

- Free AHNA Foundations of Holistic Nursing (FOHN)
 Self-Study Course
- ANA/AHNA Holistic Nursing Scope and Standards 3rd Edition Book
- \$100 Gift Certificate for the AHNA Shop (Continuing Education or SWAG purchases)
- Mentorship from an AHNCC certificant for the duration of the application and testing period.
- Application fee for certification
- Practice test fee
- Examination Registration cost
- Re-sitting fee if needed

We are committed to uplift the contributions of nurse coaches from a wide range of backgrounds and identities, through knowledge sharing, that honors diverse healing traditions and perspectives. Nurse Coach Fellowship is offered on the odd years at this time.

This mission drives us to offer ourselves as instruments of healing, while also committing to equity, diversity, inclusion, belonging, and social justice as unifying forces of equality.

Our intent is to partner with other diverse nursing organizations, every 2 years, to increase inclusivity and diversity among our certificants. The Nursing organizations partnering with AHNCC choose which of their members will receive the Fellowship.

Through these partnerships, we are focusing on

strengthening and expanding the specialized role of nurse coaching by broadening sociocultural awareness, in order to enhance our ability to provide optimal holistic care that is inclusive to all. This mission drives us to offer ourselves as facilitators of healing, while also committing to equity, diversity, inclusion, belonging, and social justice as unifying forces of equality.

AHNCC partners with Nurse Coach educational programs who provide this complimentary Nurse Coach education program.

In this two-year Fellowship, recipients are offered a packet that is valued at over \$2500.00 and includes the following:

- Mentorship from an AHNCC certified Nurse Coach for the duration of the application and testing period.
- Free tuition from a recognized Nurse Coach Educational program that covers both the required 60 contact hours and the 60 supervision hours.
- Practice test fee
- Examination Registration cost
- Re-sitting fee if needed
- A copy of the 2nd edition of the Art and Competencies of Nurse Coaching

Both Fellowship programs are available to members thru the Diverse Nursing organizations.






