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Getting Started: Nurse Coaching Certification Quick Guide

Nurse Coaching is a skilled, purposeful, results-oriented, and structured relationship-centered, interaction-based role with clients based in the precepts of Holistic Nursing wherein clients are facilitated in achieving health-focused goals.

Here is a quick guide to help you apply for Certification in Nurse Coaching. A simple breakdown of the steps required. This guide might not directly apply to those who are currently international. You can find more information about that in our more detailed guide, or on our website.

1) Eligibility Criteria

- a. ALL applications/certifications require an unrestricted, current RN license. I am sorry but we do not accept LPN or LVN applicants.
- b. Active Practice:
 - I. Associate or Diploma degree in Nursing: RN for a minimum of 4 years full time or 8,000 hours part time within the past 7 years.
 - II. Baccalaureate degree in Nursing or higher: RN for a minimum of 2 years full time or 4,000 hours part time within the past 5 years.
- c. Completion of a minimum of 60 CNEs consistent with the Nurse Coach Core Values and competencies. Must be accrued over the past 3 years. You can find that information in the links below.

- d. Completion of 60 hours coaching experience that has been mentored and/or supervised by an AHNCC certified Nurse Coach supervisor along with a validation letter.
 - Nurse Coach programs can help meet these requirements. You can find the list of Nurse Coaching programs at the link below. Some programs offer Holistic Nursing in addition to Nurse Coaching.
